

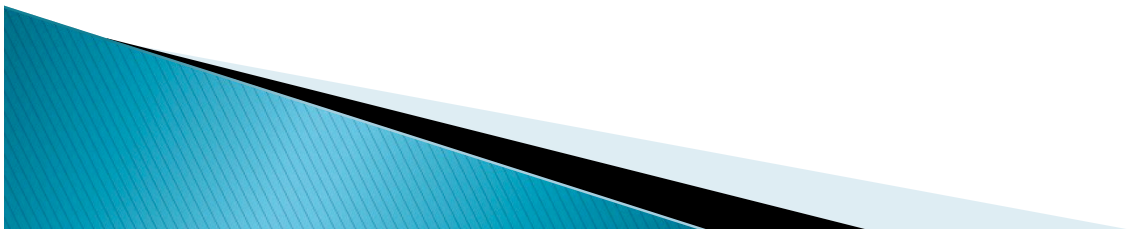

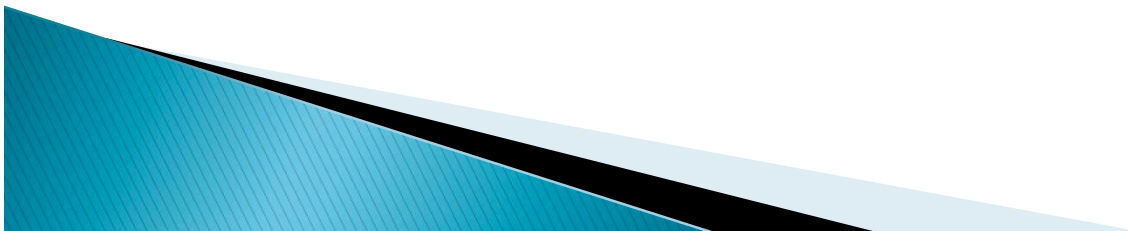
Concept

- Rotary Club of Kampala Wandegeya Adopt a School project was initiated in 2018/2019.
- To achieve Literacy and Quality Education
- We adopted a structured program called **T-E-A-C-H**
(**Teacher Support, E- Learning, Adult Literacy, Child Development and Happy School**)
- Strive High school is a community school located in the ghettos of Kawaala, Kasubi on the suburb of Kampala city.



Goals for TEACH

- To re-train and retool School teachers.
- Facilitate each student to get the best E-learning facilities.
- Adult literacy and skill adults to enable them live with honour.
- That each student gets to see, hear, read and use high class learning material for better grades.
- Every child in the community to be able to go to school
- To turn the School into a 'Happy School'.

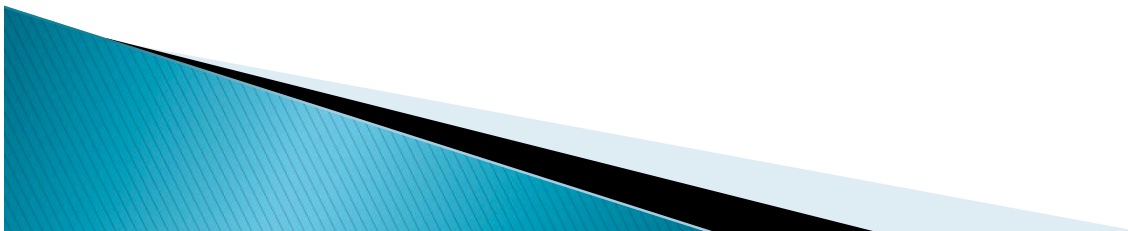

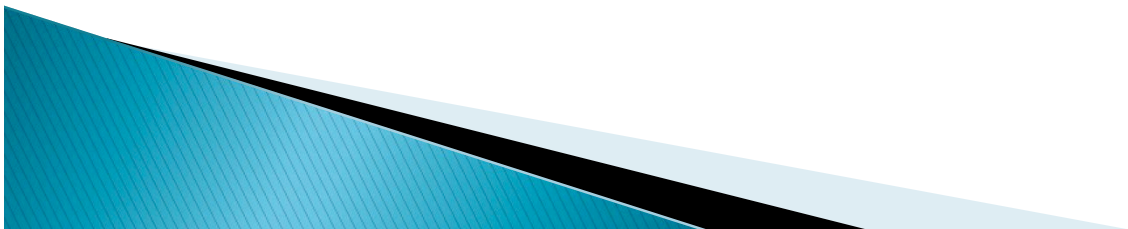

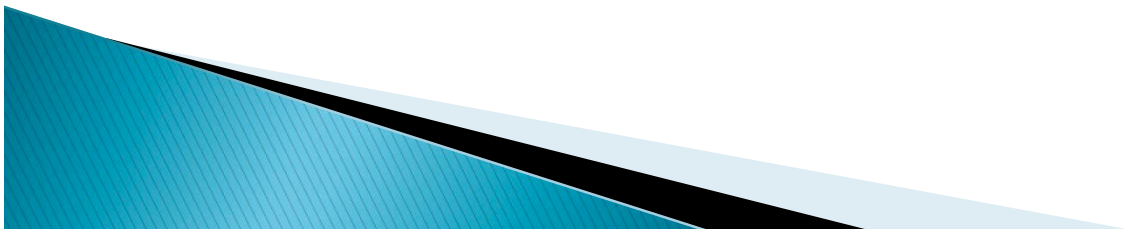

To train teachers to enhance learning outcomes



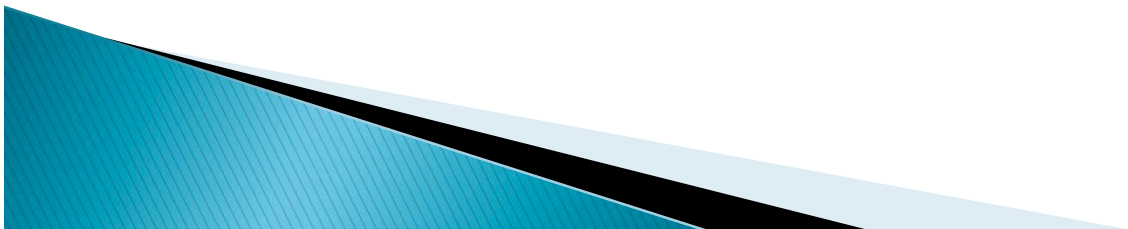
Teacher Support

- Strengthening of Schools of Education and Training by upgrading the infrastructure and training materials.

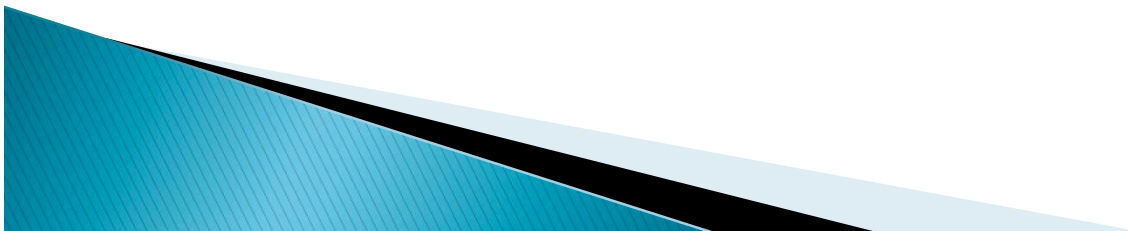
E-learning

To establish E-learning centres



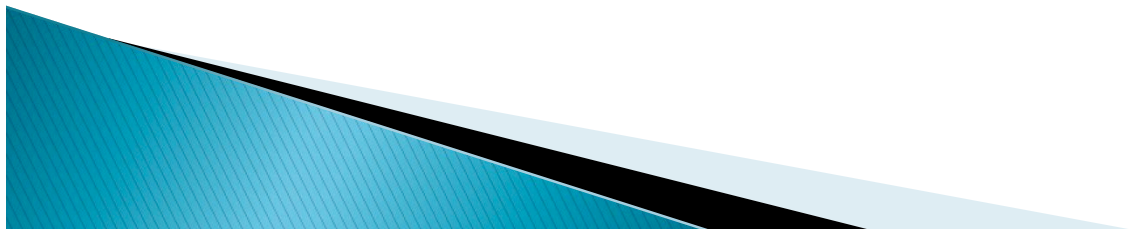
E-learning

Adult Literacy

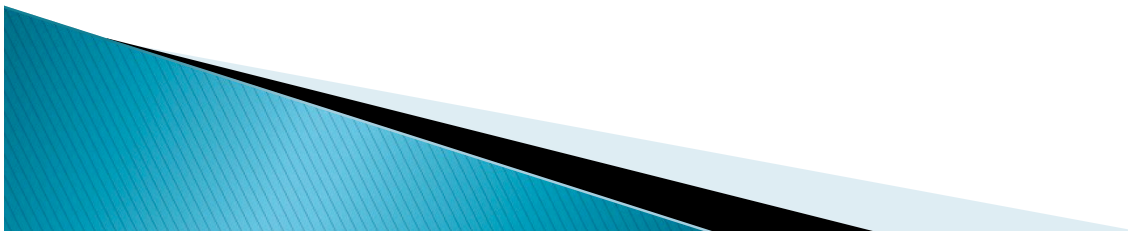
To make adults literate and skill them during school holidays

The Adult Literacy program seeks to:

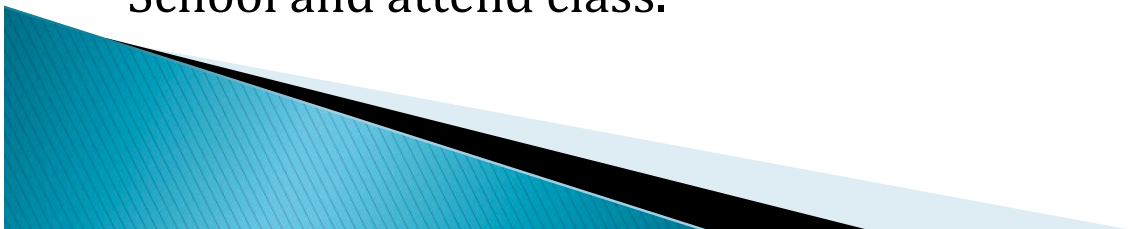
- Educate non-literates above the age of 30 years in communities around Strive High School.
- Impart skill development training to adult non-literates leveraging available government assistance like *the presidential initiative in skilling the girl child.*



Adult Literacy

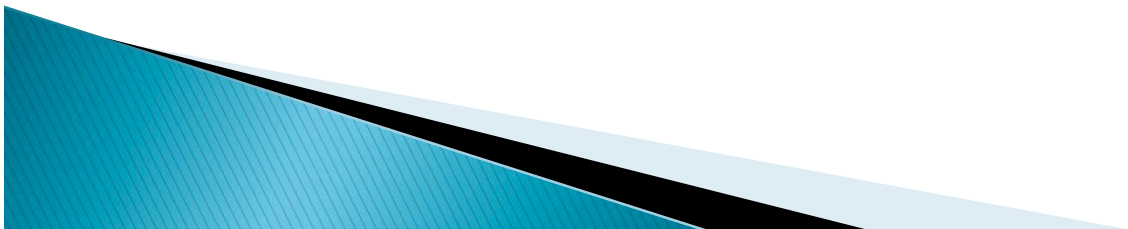
The program is implemented through:

- **Rotary Club of Kampala Wandegeya Dream:** A campaign, where a school student can teach an adult non-literate by using specially developed primers.
- **Literacy Centre:** Rotary Club of Kampala Wandegeya can set up an Adult Literacy Centre (ALC) at Strive High school to affect the community. A volunteer-teacher mobilizes the non-literate adults to come to Strive High School and attend class.



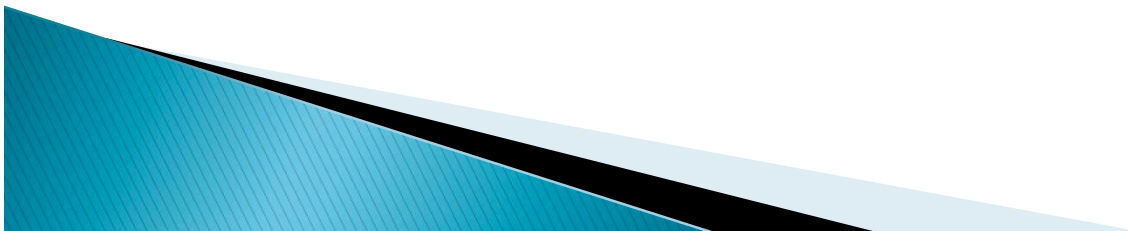
Child Development

Child Development

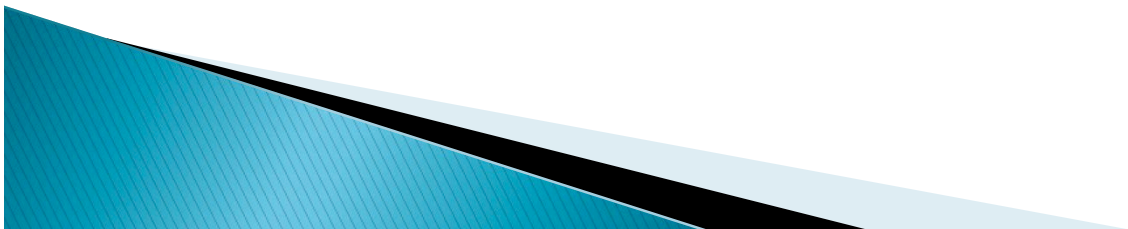
- The Child Development program of RCKW is to bring/send school children that are out of school back to schools.
- The objective is to facilitate with scholastic materials towards the children's access to mainstream government funded primary/ elementary schools. The project is called **Rotary Club of Kamapala Wandegeya... Unity For Children's Hope**".



Child Development

Strive High Community Children are:

- Child between the age of 7 to 14 yrs
- Who has never been to school or
- Who is not attending school for more than 45 days without any information to school or
- Laggard in comparison to their age and class.
- Lacked school basic requirements to go to school



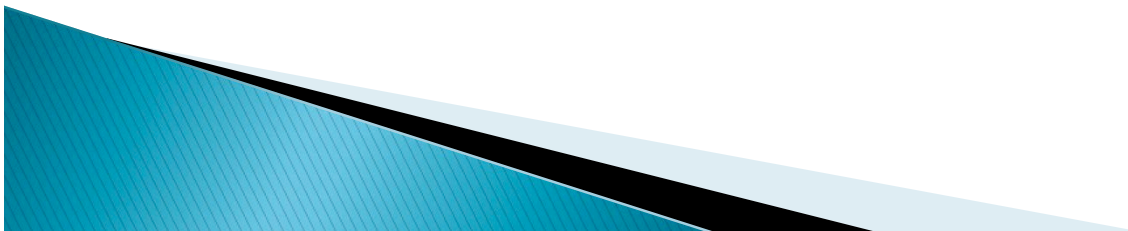
Happy School

To adopt and transform Education



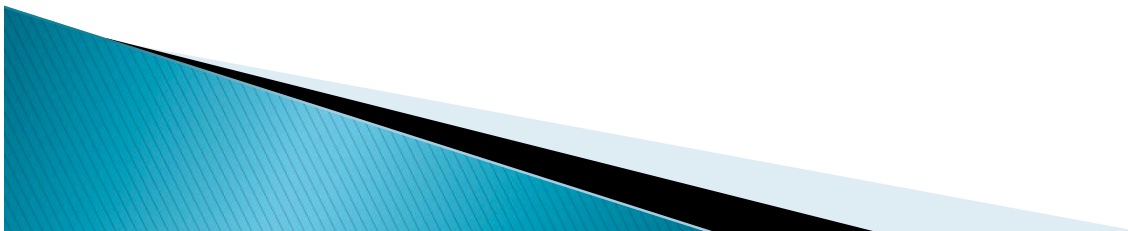
Happy School

- Provide/ upgrade infrastructural and/ or co-scholastic facilities there to make them attractive and happy learning/ teaching places for students/ teachers.



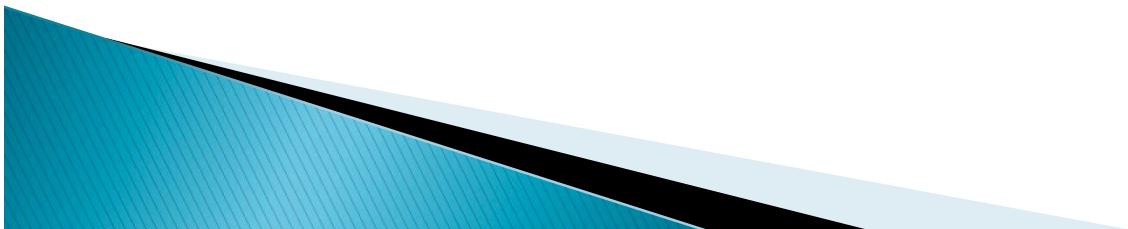
Proposed Partnerships

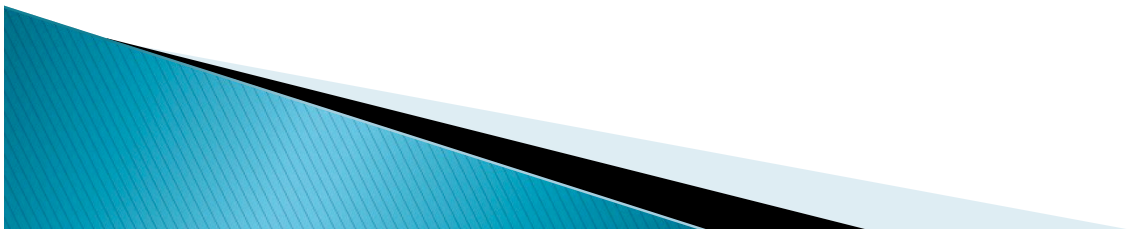
Need of Volunteer Management
